

To help manage work flow, the Express Talk system displays the contents of each recorder, both in number of jobs remaining to be transcribed, and total time of those jobs. An automatic audit trail prints a running record of total workload, dictation activity by author, time work arrives, and when it's erased.

Because dictation can be remotely accessed, the system can accommodate both centralized and de-centralized routing environments, from a central word processing pool to a dedicated secretarial structure...or any combination of the two.
